



Health CPR Session - Mumbai, Maharashtra



Sessions on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) were organised at 2 of the commercial premises in Mumbai, where participation was open to all the workers and visitors accessing the commercial premise.

The primary objective of the sessions was to educate on the critical role of CPR in **saving lives during cardiac emergencies**. It focused on :

- Immediate **response** in cardiac arrest cases
- Proper techniques for performing CPR
- Practical session Hands-on CPR on a mannequin

Education Sakhiyon ki Baadi - Rajasthan



Sakhiyon ki Baadi - A flagship program of IIFL Foundation committed to eradicate female illiteracy from Rajasthan, with community based learning centers delivering **Foundational Literacy & Numeracy (FLN) Skills,** to girls (4-14 yrs old)




32,104 girls are currently learning at Sakhiyon ki Baadi centres across 15 districts of Rajasthan









Each Sakhiyon Ki Baadi operates for 4 hours a day and 6 six days of a week. Learning at Sakhiyon Ki Baadi happens through interactive sessions by adopting play- way method, music, drama and exposure to the field.

The programme has been instrumental in mainstreaming 25,000 girls to Government schools

Education Holistic Development of 102 Govt. Girls Schools





IIFL Foundation entered a MOU with the Government of Rajasthan to bring holistic development at **102 Government Girls Schools** across Udaipur district, to **promote enrollment** and **retention** of girls in the schools, over next **3 years**.







Installation of **Smart TVs** and setting up of **Computer Labs**, for students to access up-to-date information and new age technology. *Girls touched a computer for the first time in their life*



Sessions on **Financial Literacy** for the girls to develop understanding on financial management, savings and Investments, at an early age to grow financially.



Winter-Kits (Sweater, Shoes and Socks), to ensure regular **attendance** during winter season, prevent dropping out.

Education Sampark Smart Shaala - Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh



IIFL Foundation, has implemented the biggest TV based learning programme (Smart Shaala) along with dissemination of the **Math Kits** in three districts of Rajasthan - Bikaner, Jaipur and Jodhpur and two **aspirational districts** of Uttar Pradesh - Sonbhadra and Chitrakoot, running from 2023 to 2025 (3 years)

This project has helped to **reduce the dropping out of students from Govt. Schools**, especially among girls, in past 3 years.

Education Financial Literacy - Rajasthan



With a view to prepare the girls for a brighter future in academics and in the society, the Foundation have taken a step to introduce **Financial Literacy** to these young minds.

Our curriculum offers a 3 month engagement with each school, with sessions covering Financial concepts of **Banking**, **Savings** & **Investments**, along with mock sessions.

Education Seva Kutir - Madhya Pradesh



IIFL Foundation supports **10 Seva Kutirs** - Day boarding supplementary meals-cum-education centers in Sheopur, Madhya Pradesh, engaging with **764 children**.







The project aims to address the problems of poor learning outcomes and malnutrition affecting **tribal children** in Madhya Pradesh in the age group of 3 to

Key features of every learning center:

- 2 nutritious meals Breakfast and lunch
- 5-6 hours of education supplemented by sports and yoga
- A **mini-library** comprising of 100 books (Prathams) to promote reading and improve comprehension skills
- Celebration of important days in a year Republic Day, Independence day, Gandhi Jayanti, National Youth Day, etc.
- Preparing children for enrollment at government school with help of Guides





Education Digital Shaala (Muskaan Dreams)



A 2 year programme where we installed **50 television sets** upgraded with educational content to improve students learning experience, in the grade 6-8th, especially for girls from 10-16 years of age, along with capacity building of the teachers.

This will benefit 240 students, with most of them are from economically weaker section of our society.

IIFL Foundation established **Computer Labs** at 2 Government Schools in partnership with the Rajasthan Government, at Kherwara Girls' Higher Secondary School and Kanabai Girls' Higher Secondary School in Udaipur district. This initiative benefits over **1200 Girl Students**.

Education Akshar Jyoti (Gavri - Folk Art)



Each performance uses mythological stories, blended with contemporary situations to promote social values and address community concerns.

We used the medium to promote awareness on **Education**, Eliminate discrimination, steps for improved health & hygiene, consequences of early marriage (Child-marriage) and dropping out of schools.










Education ASER Report (Rajasthan)




Livelihood Skills Development for Youths (Baramulla)


