

# **EDUCATION INITIATIVES**

Our goal is to enroll out-of-school girls into formal education systems by establishing and improving existing educational facilities with a focus on digital literacy.

#### Sakhiyon Ki Baadi

An initiative to eradicate female illiteracy in rural Rajasthan, through community-based learning centres for girls in the age group of 4 to 14 years, especially from the Scheduled tribe communities. The programme has grown from 100 to 1,185 centers covering 15 districts, impacting lives of more than 40,000+ girls till date. The program will be further strengthened by an upgraded pedagogical intervention to promote age and grade appropriate learning, during FY 24-25.

#### **Chauras**

This unique project addresses the education gap among children of migrant labourers by establishing learning and day-care centres at construction sites, brick kilns and stone processing units, to ensure continued learning of children at move (Rajasthan, Gujarat and Delhi NCR).

IIFL Foundation has been at the forefront for protecting and conserving environment under our 'GROW' mandate.

#### Botanical Garden

To promote plant sciences as well as research, a botanical garden has been developed at Institute of Science, Mumbai, planting 1031 herbal saplings of 86 varieties. This garden has provided an opportunity to the students to access saplings for their research at their institute only.





#### Urban Forest

Under the Project, the IIFL Foundation partnered with Maharashtra government's 'Mumbai Climate Action Plan', to increase plant cover in Mumbai. 1,397 trees and 10,297 shrubs were planted under this initiative, promoting green cover in Mumbai city.

## Miyawaki Forest

In collaboration with BMC, a garden has been developed on a 2500 Sq. Mtr. piece of land in Chembur, Maharashtra with plantation of 10,400 indigenous plant species which are 100% organic, wild, fast growing & self-sustainable following the Miyawaki technique.









## Arvi River Project

Under partnership with Maharashtra Govt., an area of 22 KM of Arvi River has been revived using artificial recharge. This initiative has helped 16 villages in district Wardha, Maharashtra.







## Check Dams

To increase ground water recharge, so that water can be withdrawn during the dry season for irrigation, livestock watering and for drinking purposes, check dams were constructed on water bodies in the Palghar region, Maharashtra.


