

500 Relief Kits were procured and shared with the covid +ve patients, across different districts of Rajasthan. Each Covid Relief Kit comprised of following particulars:



Health Ophthalmic Ward



IIFL Foundation donated medical equipment to **Primary Health Center (PHC)** at Khamnor (rural) for setting up an Ophthalmic Ward.

This is the first and only facility of such kind in the village, that shall be beneficial to people dwelling in a radius of 30 kms.

Installed at **Dept.** of **Endoscopy**, **KEM Hospital**, **Mumbai**.

The department carries out approximately 900 procedures every year, which requires extensive usage of ESG unit. The existing ESG machine at the facility was 8 years old and lacked a lot of critical coagulation and cutting modes.

This state-of-art medical equipment will benefit the economically weaker families to cut the cost of treatment.

Cost of one procedure in a private clinic comes around Rs.15,000, while the services at the KEM Hospital (Government) would charge less than Rs.500 per procedure.





IIFL Foundation donated **C Arm X-ray Machine** to the Orthopaedic Ward - Surgery Dept., at the Govt. Hospital (Udaipur).

C Arm provides highresolution X-ray images in real time and physician can track progress and can alter the configuration anytime during operation.

Patients from lower income group, across districts of Udaipur, Dungarpur and Bicchiwara access treatment at Govt. Hospital (Udaipur) that offers **Free-of-cost** treatments and surgeries.

Health Development at Govt. Hospital



IIFL Foundation has undertaken the responsibility to reactivate the dormant wards at the **Maharana Bhupal Government Hospital, Udaipur**.

The work entails repair of the existing rooms and setting up of following wards

Operations Theatres (OT) - 3 Nos.

Intensive Care Unit (ICU) - 1 Nos. (5 Beds)

Outpatient Department - 1 Nos.

Senior Doctors Cabins - 2 Nos.

Waiting Area - 1 Nos.

The setup will be completed with installation of Medical Equipments in the OT, OPD and ICU and furnishing the wards (Ceiling, Flooring, Electrical Fixtures)





Health Ambulance (Raj. & Tamil Nadu)



In case of an life-saving medical emergency arising at **rural** locations, patients often need to rush to nearest city to get required medical treatment.

IIFL Foundation donated 2 Ambulances (Rajasthan & Tamil Nadu) to offer free of cost service to marginalized population dwelling in rural settlements.

Health Drone project



Delivering Covid-19 vaccines is challenging in many parts of India, given to the geographical obstacles. Regions that are mountainous, hilly or divided by water bodies are hard to reach.

IIFL Foundation's initiative empowered delivery of covid-19 vaccines in **9 minutes and 30 seconds** by drone, across the distance that takes 70 minutes by road.

"Maharashtra has always been at the forefront of implementing innovative initiatives -- transporting vaccines by drones has made reaching health care for the people in the remote tribal regions much easier and wider," - Uddhav Thackeray, Chief Minister - Maharashtra.










Education Sakhiyon ki Baadi











Place

Sakhiyon Ki Baadi runs in a place allotted by the community *viz.* someone's house, veranda, community hall or perhaps a common open area.

Daksha

A learning facilitator (female) is selected from the community, who is willing to brave the challenge. Min qualification is 10th pass, we look for desire, commitment & willingness to learn!

Functioning

Operating for 4 hours a day and 6 days a week. Post pandemic, sessions were conducted online (Google meet) and girls attended in groups, over phone lent by community member


Participation & ownership of the SKB centre by the community members is ensured right from the onset of this program. After all true change shall come only over change in mindset of the community







Education Sakhiyon ki Baadi (Online)

Education Digital Learning Tools



In post-COVID era, classrooms have moved to online platforms. However, children from rural areas lack access to technology and hardware.

IIFL Foundation has empowered these students with **Android Tablets**, enabling them to access **Diksha** Learning App (Developed by NCERT, Ministry of Education) to progress academically. A total of **200** tablets distributed among 4 Govt. Schools in a pilot phase.

Education Seva Kutir (Learning Centres)







A learning centre for holistic development of children from marginalised communities.

Key Activities:

- 2 meals daily (Breakfast & Dinner) to every child
- 5-6 hours of activity based on Education, Sports, Yog. etc..
- Celebration of events such as Independence Day, Republic Day, Gandhi Jayanti,
 National Youth Day etc.
- A mini-library collection of 100 books (Pratham's) at each Seva Kutir, for children to read and improve their reading and comprehension skills.
- Value Education Sessions once/twice in a week on themes such as "Self Awareness"; Responsibility"; "Nothing but the Truth"etc. "
- Teachers' Training for 2 days Every Month by District Education Anchors & Cluster Supervisors covering teaching methodology as well as content.

Education Scholarships for Girls



Every year in India millions of talented, meritorious & needy students belonging to underprivileged segment of the society are unable to reach their full potential due to lack of affordable financing, which further leads to voluntary dropouts. **Financial affordability contributes** to more than 57% of the total dropouts in the country.

Female students studying in the classes between 9th Grade (School) to 15th Grade (College), can apply for this scholarship over online portal. The shortlisted candidates are interviewed by our team, followed by a verification of documents & Income proof by due diligence team. The applicants that qualify for scholarship are awarded by making payment directly to the scholar's bank account.



IIFL Foundation also sponsored education of a student to attend Kohinoor college of Hotel & Tourism management studies (Mumbai) and another student (10th Std), both child of a commercial sex worker.





Education Rathshaala



IIFL Foundation's unique initiative **Rathshaala** is a *school-on-wheels*t hat travels along with the nomadic tribe of Rebaris. The community migrates with their families and cattle for over 8 months in a year, in search of new pasture lands for their cattle and carrying out trade, livelihood offered by their cattle.

Formal literacy among the tribe is very low as they are seldom stationed at a location for more than a few weeks. IIFL Foundation's Rathshaala, travels along the caravan, and is led by a teacher who conducts learning session for children from the tribe, twice in a day.

During Covid-19 pandemic, the tribe faced difficulty in mobilisation and thus stationed themselves at village on Gujarat-Rajasthan border.

IIFL Foundation helped them with a teacher and learning resource material to sustain the education of








Education Chauras











Chauras is a learning centre cum crèche for children of migrant construction site workers. Chauras operates from 9:00 am to 5:30 pm through the weekdays and provides basic functional literacy & nutritional meals to the children. The age group spans from the youngest being 3 months old to an adolescent of 14 years of age

The centre regained its operation observing the safety guidelines issued by the Health Ministry of India to prevent spread of Covid-19. Routine health check-up and vaccination of the children was conducted in July.

Education for underprivileged



Since 2018, IIFL Foundation has been supporting education of the children from the **Financially weaker section** of the community residing at Janupada Vaibhav Nagar locality (slum settlement) located at Kandivali (E), Mumbai. Parents of almost 90% of enrolled students earn their livelihood through menial occupations and find it difficult to meet financial demands to offer their children quality education.

The school was on verge of closing down during 2018, facing scarcity of funds and since then IIFL Foundation has helped them sustain the operations. Children are offered education 'free of charge' and not charged any fee.

IIFL Foundation has **supported farmers** from low income groups to venture and progress in the vertical of **Dairy production**. This Livestock Development project is operational in **3 states** across India – Rajasthan, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, with a total of 7 centres.

This initiative provides services / inputs at the doorstep of the cattle owners to encourage and maintain livestock rearing as a secondary source of income, promote production of dairy services.



offering a platform for NGOs, Self Help groups and community based groups to showcase and sell their products directly to customers across India. The services of this platform are offered 'free of cost' to the users.



As part of its employee engagement initiatives, IIFL Foundation organized a tree plantation drive in Mumbai, to promote awareness and act upon the risks arising from climate change.


